

Information about the Region

Gunnedah Shire is located in the North West Slopes region of New South Wales, Australia. The Shire has an area of approximately 5,001 square kilometres with a population of 12,989. The shire includes the township of **Gunnedah and 7 villages - Breeza, Carroll, Curlewis, Emerald Hill, Kelvin, Mullaley and Tambar Springs**. Gunnedah is located 440 kilometres from Sydney, adjacent to the Liverpool Plains on the Namoi River Valley and is traversed by the Oxley Highway and the Kamilaroi Highway.

The Namoi Valley is considered to be one of Australia's richest pockets of agricultural land and Gunnedah Shire is also located on one of Australia's wealthiest mineral seams, in an area now internationally known as the Gunnedah Basin.

Agriculture and rural industry have long been the backbone of the local economy, with rich farm land and abundant underground water supporting a strong and growing processing industry based on local agricultural products. These include grain milling plants, stock feed plants, a leather processor, cotton gin, canola processing plant, linseed plant, sunflower seed processing plant and a citrus packing and sorting plant.

Known as 'The Koala Capital', Gunnedah's unique natural landscape is home to many species of native wildlife and paints a picture of real country Australia. It is little wonder that this beautiful area inspired poet Dorothea Mackellar to author "My Country". Gunnedah is rich in local history, from the stories of Red Chief of the Land of the Kamilaroi people dating back thousands of years, to the remains of an ancient Diprotodon that were found in fields of Tambar Springs.
