Information about the Region

The Lockyer Valley is an area of rich farmlands that lies to the west of Brisbane, and east of Toowoomba. It straddles the Warrego Highway and covers an area of approximately 2,200 sq kms and is considered to be rated among the top ten most fertile farming areas in the world. The intensively cultivated area grows a diverse range of commercial fruit and vegetables. The valley is referred to as "Australia's Salad Bowl" and has been described as one of Australia's premium food bowls.

The population is growing quickly and there are currently around 35,000 residents. Projections by the Department of Infrastructure and Planning show that the Lockyer Valley region's population is expected to grow to 57,443 by 2031. As commuters move into the area, urban planning measures have been implemented to preserve the good quality agricultural land and rural feel of the valley.

The Lockyer Valley is home to so much more than farming and agriculture, it's home to a blend of town and country living with everything from top class restaurants and art galleries to bird watching, roadside produce stalls, horse riding, stunning national parks and bushwalking.
