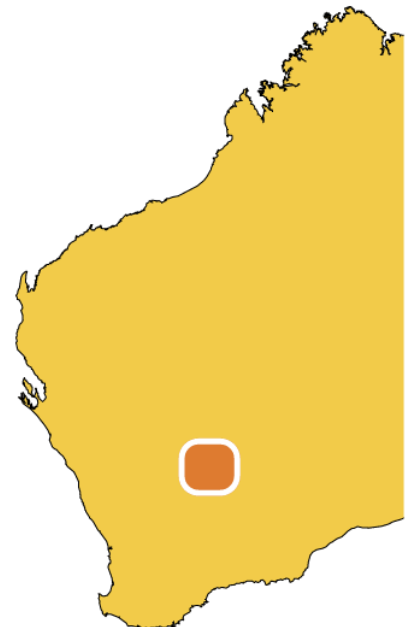
About the Region

The Shire of Leonora is situated within the Northern Goldfields region of Western Australia. The main township of Leonora is located approximately 830km northeast of Perth and 237km north of Kalgoorlie-Boulder. It is a service centre for the mining, exploration, and pastoral industries.

The Shire covers an area of 31,958sq km and is home to a diverse community, including a large fly-in-fly-out workforce. Due to the transient nature of visitors and workers, the population fluctuates from around 800 to 1,500 people.

Gold was first discovered in the area in 1895 and a year later the townsite of Leonora was established. Leonora started as a small settlement of hessian shacks, but the town quickly grew and by the early 1900s had a population of over 1000 people.

In 1963 the closure of the Sons of Gwalia mine substantially effected the population of the neighbouring settlement of Gwalia. However, the townsite of Leonora continued to thrive due to alternative economic revenue streams. Today, the mining and pastoral industries are still going strong throughout the Shire, with cattle being the main pastoral commodity, and gold and nickel being produced in large quantities.
